TO BE A MEMBER OF THE BRANIFF RETIREMENT CLUB YOU MUST BE IN THE EMPLOYMENT RECORDS AND BE OF RETIREMENT STATUS, AGE 55 OR OLDER. DUES FOR MEMBERSHIP ARE **\$15.00 PER YEAR** PER PERSON (YEARLY) OR A ONE TIME FEE OF **\$60.00** PER PERSON FOR A LIFETIME MEMBERSHIP, YOU CHOOSE THE MEMBERSHIP YOU WANT. YOU MUST BE A MEMBER TO OBTAIN THE ID PASS PRIVILEGE CARD, ONE ID PASS CARD PER MEMBERSHIP.

(ID CARD INFORMATION)

THIS INFORMATION IS NEEDED TO SUPPLY EACH MEMBER OF THE BRANIFF CLUB AN IDENTIFICATION CARD TO OBTAIN PASS PRIVILEGES WITH **AIRLINE RETIREES PASS BUREAU** (ARPB) AND OTHER TRAVEL SERVICES WHO GIVES DISCOUNT PRIVILEGES. YOU MAY BE ASKED TO SHOW THE ID CARD PLUS A VALID DRIVERS LICENSE WHEN YOU FLY. IF YOU ARE THE SPOUSE OF A DECEASED BRANIFF CLUB MEMBER EMPLOYEE WHO WAS A MEMBER, YOU WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR PASSES UNDER THE NAME OF THE DECEASED BRANIFF EMPLOYEE. YOU MUST BE A MEMBER TO OBTAIN A ID PASS CARD, A **\$4.00** FEE IS REQUIRED TO PROCESS THE ID CARD, IF BOTH HUSBAND AND SPOUSE WANT ID CARDS, BOTH MUST BECOME MEMBERS, A \$4.00 FEE FOR EACH. YOU MUST BE A CLUB MEMBER TO RECEIVE AN ID PASS PRIVILEGE CARD, ONE ID CARD PER MEMBERSHIP.
